FOUNDATION PHASE 3

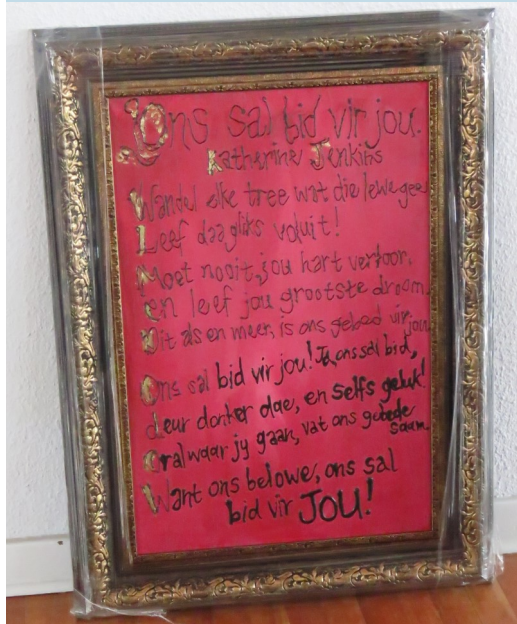

RESOLUTIONS TO CHARGE SCHOOL FEES

Pursuant to a meeting of the parents of ALMA SCHOOL on 26 November 2016, the following resolution was passed by a majority of parents, in accordance with Act 38 (2) of the South African Schools Act, 84 of 1996 as amended:

- ◆ That the school fees shall be regulated and determined as follows:

Annual school fees for each learner shall be an amount of R7 150.00 which shall be payable in 11 equal instalments of R650.00 monthly commencing in January 2017 terminating in November 2017.

Transport fees (where applicable) for each learner shall be an amount of R15 600.00 (full) / R11,700.00 (single), which shall be payable in 12 equal instalments of R1 300.00 (full) / R975.00 (single), monthly commencing in January 2017 terminating in December 2017.

- ◆ That the Governing Body shall, upon receiving an application for exemption from payment of school fees, apply the formula in its determination of such application in accordance of the Regulations published in Government Gazette Nr. 29311, Vol. 496 of 18 October 2006.
- ◆ That the school budget shall reflect the estimated cumulative effect of:

The established tendency of non-payment of the school fees; and the total, partial and provisional exemptions granted to parents in terms of the Regulations promulgated in accordance with Article 39(4) of the South African Schools Act, 84 of 1996 as amended.

Any further enquiries can be made at the school. All documentation mentioned above is available at the school for your perusal.
