The project is part of the "Save-a-Child" organization.

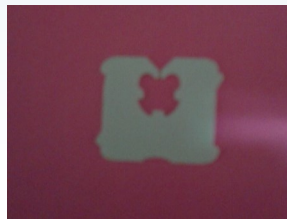
How to help us?

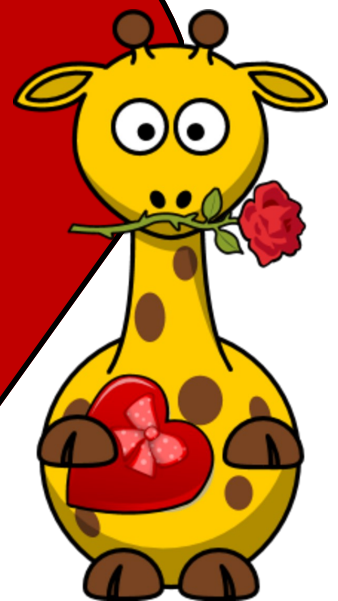
