## IMPORTANT!!!!!

#### RE: CHANGES IN ALMA SCHOOL'S BUS SERVICE FOR 2018 AS DISCUSSED BY THE SGB

Due to the current economic situation and various other factors outside of our control, Alma School is forced to make certain changes with regards to the bus service that we are currently offering to the parents and learners of Alma School. **Decisions were taken by the SGB and discussed with current bus users at a meeting held on Tuesday 7 November 2017. The most important changes include:** 

#### • The bus routes will change

We are forced to revisit the distances the buses travel daily, and we will have to limit these routes or implement a cut-off radius.

#### • Pick-up & drop off points

Pick-up points (e.g. at a garage) will be identified along the routes and parents will have to deliver and in some cases, collect their children at these points at specified times.

- All bus users will pay full price for the use of transport As from 2018, bus fees will no longer be subsidized by the school, with no exceptions. A proposed bus fee of R1350 p/m (payable for 12 months) for 2018 will be presented for approval during the Annual General Meeting.
- All parents must re-apply for a space on the bus for their child for 2018 Due to the changes to be implemented, there will be less space on the buses as from 2018. <u>No</u> <u>quarantees can be given that we will be able to accommodate your child in 2018.</u>

This is your final opportunity to apply for space on the Alma School bus routes for 2018. Complete the tear off slip and send it back to school no later than Monday, 20 November 2017 as bus routes will be planned and hopefully finalized during this week.
